How Your Insurance Works

- 1. Read your network and coverage books- they help to explain what services are covered and which providers you can go see
- 2. Always keep your current insurance card with you at all times
- 3. Make sure you know what services are direct access and which services you must have a referral for
- 4. Help your providers out by knowing your own medical history and what your needs are
- 5. Call your insurance company and find out the name of your care coordinator/case manager
- 6. Find out if your insurance company covers your equipment- can it be fixed and replaced if necessary
- 7. Expect your coverage to change when you turn 21
