ICD-10 Codes for Specific Substance-Induced Anxiety Disorder

Coding for substance-induced anxiety disorders depends upon the substance or medication involved and the level of use.

The substance or medication being used makes up the first 3 digits of the diagnostic code:

Anxiety due to	Code prefix
Alcohol	F10
Opioid	F11
Cannabis	F12
Sedatives, hypnotics, anxiolytics	F13
Cocaine	F14
Other stimulants, including caffeine	F15
Hallucinogen	F16
Nicotine	F17
Inhalants	F18
Other psychoactive substances and multiple drug use	F19

Exceptions include F11 (opioids) and F17 (nicotine) which do have specifiers for anxiety, so the following codes would apply:

<u>F11.188</u> Opioid abuse with other opioid-induced disorder (such as anxiety)

<u>F11.288</u> Opioid dependence with other opioid-induced disorder (such as anxiety)

<u>F11.988</u> Opioid use, unspecified with other opioid-induced disorder (such as anxiety)

F17.209 Nicotine dependence with unspecified nicotine-induced disorders
